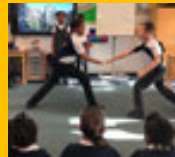
wonderful performances Henry Fawcett Primary School is famous for. Thank you for your continued generosity and support!

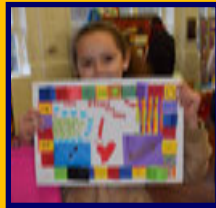
