This term we will be continuing to learn about 'Traditional Tales'. We will also be looking at shapes and patterns and moving onto learn about numbers up to 15.

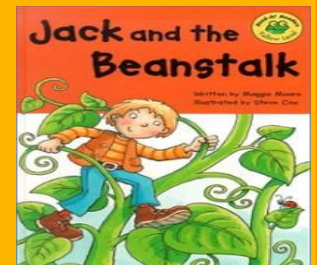
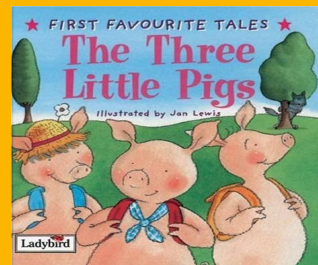
## WORLD BOOK DAY THURSDAY 1ST MARCH 2018
