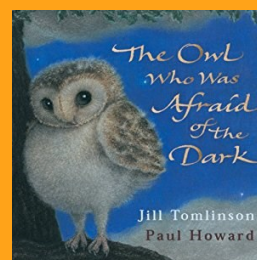
Welcome Back to a New Term!

We hope that you all had a well deserved rest during the half-term break and are looking forward to a new term of learning. Our topic this term is 'Nocturnal Animals' and we have some exciting ways of developing this learning.

Focus for this term:

Literacy

As we are learning about nocturnal animals, our first book for this term will be Jill Tomlinson's "The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark". This is a beautiful story about overcoming our fears. This will also be our theme for World Book Day! We can't wait to see all the exciting nocturnal animal costumes the children wear.



Numeracy

For numeracy this term we will be building upon our knowledge of subtraction. Children will be learning different methods of subtraction and how to apply and check them using the inverse. Please make sure that you keep up to date with Mathematics as we will use this to assess your child's learning of the lessons taught in school.

Educational Visits:

At Henry Fawcett we love to compliment the children's learning with educational trips and visits. Next week Year 2 will be visiting the Science Museum to take part in an exciting workshop all about 'Space'. Please remember school rain jackets must be worn on school trips.
