Term 3 2017/2018

After a successful Autumn term the Year 4 team are excited to start the Spring term.

Numeracy:

In Numeracy this term we will again be making sure we are confident in our formal written methods, whilst also improving our mental maths skills. This term we are taking on the 'golden 100' times tables challenge and hope to be times table whizz kids by the end of the term. In addition to this we will also be looking at different measurements and even doing some cooking!

Literacy

In literacy we wrote our own stories using our class book as a stimulus. We also learnt how to make a non-fiction report about animals found in Antarctica.



This term we will be reading 'Leon and the Place between'. We have already had a busy start to the term with Year 4 having the circus come to town and helping Abdul Kazam get more people to come to his circus.

Theatre workshop

We are extremely lucky to be having the young theatre makers project coming in to do workshops with Year 4. This will start on Tuesday 9th January and the children will have 5 sessions. We hope that this will help with the children's imaginations and therefore creativity and writing.

Science Garden

Year 4 are to have Urban Canopy coming in every Monday to help develop the pond area. They used the foliage that was cut down to make Christmas wreaths and have even made their own plans for the pond area. We are excited to see it develop.
